



Submission Guidelines

General Information

AAIET'2025 welcomes original and unpublished contributions that address theoretical, methodological, and practical aspects of Artificial Intelligence and Emerging Technologies. Submissions should clearly highlight the novelty, relevance, and significance of the proposed work.

All papers must be written in English and submitted in **PDF format only** through the online submission portal:

The conference follows the **IEEE standard format**. Authors are required to prepare their manuscripts using the official IEEE template (download links provided at the end of this section).

Paper Categories

Authors may submit their work in one of the following categories:

- **Regular Papers (6–8 pages):** Presenting completed and original research contributions.
- **Short Papers (4–5 pages):** Presenting preliminary results, work-in-progress, or case studies.
- **Demo Papers (2–3 pages):** Describing innovative system demonstrations, prototypes, or tools.

Note: All page limits include figures, tables, references, and appendices.

Submission Process

Step 1: Visit the Submission Portal

Step 2: Sign In or Register

- If you already have a CMT account, click “**Sign In.**”
- New users should click “**Register**” to create a free account.

Step 3: Create a New Submission

- Click “**Create New Submission**” under AAIET'2025.
- Enter the title and abstract of your paper.

Step 4: Upload Your PDF File

- Prepare your manuscript using the official IEEE template.
- Upload your final PDF file **only**.
- Ensure the file name follows this convention: `Firstname_Lastname.pdf`
(Example: *Benrazek_Alaeddine.pdf*)

Q Review Process

All submissions will undergo a **single-blind peer review** by at least two members of the AAIET'2025 Scientific Committee.

Accepted papers will be scheduled for presentation during the conference (oral or poster) and included in the official conference program.
